





Dec 2020


Production catch up activities resulted in total of 117 resumption wells in 2020 (7 wells additional compare to WPB R1 target).



GPOC Production and Lifting from 2012 to Q1 2021






*Note: Annualized Production data for 2021is year end projection & for 2022 – 2025 are forecast.

- Since resumption in 2018, cumulative lifting has reached 35.1 mil bbl in Q1, 2021 and expected to reach >40 mil bbl by 2021.
- Post resumption, all GPOC staff were recalled to enhance the oil production.

Additional to CD programs, GPOC also build & maintain roads


 The communities are benefiting from more than 400 km of Operation road and more community roads covering all the 5 fields have been planned for.




Filled Position by National Staff and Foreign Nationals in GPOC



Technical / HSSE

- Managing some Aging Assets and facilities.
- Occasional Security issues.



Logistics

- Limited access to GPOC fields due to bad roads conditions during raining season.
- Covid-19 related challenges.
- Custom clearance processes and bordercrossing requirements hamper smooth delivery of materials.
- Contractors' capacity and material resources issues
