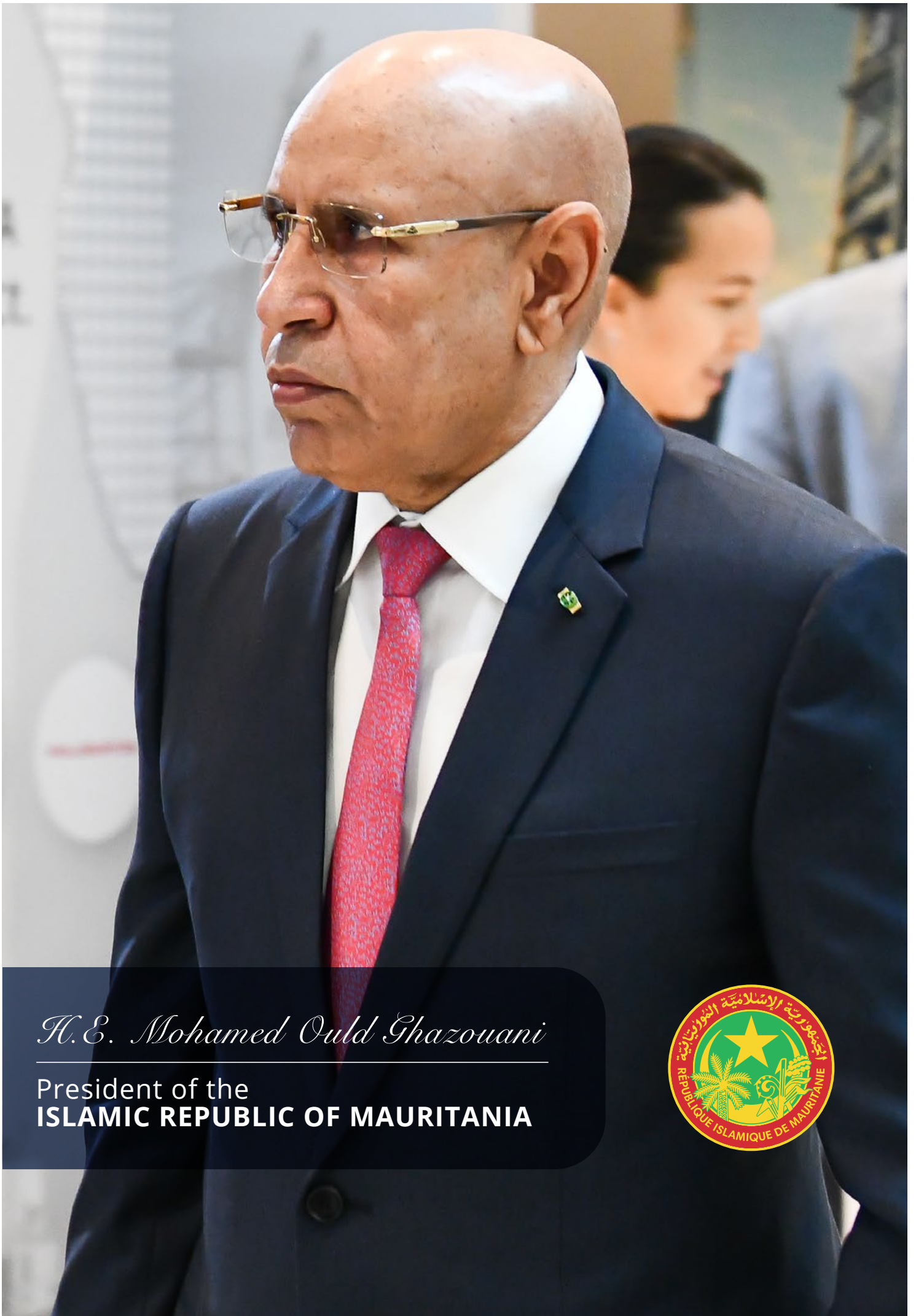

DISCUSSIONS CENTER ON INVESTMENT



The MSGBC Oil, Gas & Power 2023 conference featured a comprehensive program covering every segment of the regional value chain. As the only conference that focuses on every country in the MSGBC region, the event stood as a testament to the region's dynamic energy landscape, where industry leaders, investors and stakeholders converge to unlock new frontiers in sustainable energy development.

The first day of the conference included an insightful opening ceremony, featuring the attendance of Mauritanian President H.E Mohamed Ould Ghazouani, as well as a ministerial panel. Both laid the foundation for two days of dialogue and deals, with industry leaders providing forward-looking remarks about the future of the MSGBC energy market.

The second day of the conference featured a packed program, with discussions ranging from hydrocarbon development, to scaling up investment opportunities,

to leveraging green hydrogen as a vector for industrialization. During these sessions, speakers examined the intricate balancing act between oil and gas monetization and the transition to cleaner energy sources.

Key takeaways included the critical role that oil and gas plays in the MSGBC region; the availability of attractive fiscal terms; and how Mauritania is poised to become a global supplier of green hydrogen. Across various panels, speakers drew attention to key projects and promising opportunities; how digital transformation has and will continue to impact the industry; and the various strategies for reducing operational costs, enhancing safety and increasing productivity.

The conference closed with remarks delivered by Mauritania's Minister of Petroleum, Mines and Energy, H.E Nani O. Chrougha, drawing an end to both an exciting and highly productive two days.

COUNTRY SPOTLIGHTS



Focus on Mauritania: Road Show on Exploration & Opportunities

During the MSGBC Oil, Gas & Power 2023 conference, a session titled, 'Focus on Mauritania: Road Show on Exploration & Opportunities', served as a bridge between government decision-makers, data-experts, and industry leaders. The country-focused session offered a platform for speakers to exchange insights, share information, and outline the future of energy exploration and development in Mauritania.

Speakers shared insight into Mauritania's exciting E&P opportunities. Key topics included the country's recently launched 15-block licensing round; the presence of investment-friendly regulation such as the Hydrocarbons Code, the Local Content Code, and the Investment Code; and the geological prospects of the Mauritanian basin.

Additionally, the session featured the launch of the Energy Service Zone Nouakchott project by global engineering, procurement and construction firm EPCM. The development project aims to provide infrastructure to key players in the Islamic Republic of Mauritania's hydrocarbons sector while incentivizing foreign direct investment.

Senegal Oil and Gas: New Investment Opportunities

Senegal's National Oil Company Petrosen held a Senegal investment showcase, looking at exploration, investment conditions and the history of its hydrocarbons industry. Arsène Frederic Boissy, Head of the Promotion Department at Petrosen E&P, also provided delegates with updates on the Sangomar, Greater Tortue Ahmeyim (GTA) and Yakaar Teranga projects.

TECHNICAL PROGRAM OUTLINES PROJECTS



The Extractive Industries Transparency Initiative (EITI) delivered a presentation and Q&A session on the second day of the conference, with Isselmou Mohamed, Managing Director, Taleb Consultis providing insight into the EITI's Mauritania report.

In parallel to the conference, MSGBC Oil, Gas & Power 2023 featured a technical program comprising market-focused presentations, country spotlight sessions and Q&A opportunities. Featured sessions on the first day of the technical program included a presentation on the MSGBC Basin: A Testbed for the Energy Transition; discussions on A Shifting Oil and Gas Innovation Landscape: The critical

role of digitalization and broader technologies in the oil industry of the future and How do Global IOCs Balance Spending Between Low-Carbon and Traditional Activities while Facing Increased Investor Pressure.

The second day of the technical program kicked off with a presentation and Q&A session on the EITI's Mauritania 2022 Report by Isselmou Mohamed, Managing Director of Taleb Consultis. Sessions that followed included a discussion by Nene Kane, Executive Director of SEPCO. Three country spotlight sessions on Guinea-Conakry, Senegal and The Gambia rounded up the technical program for the event.

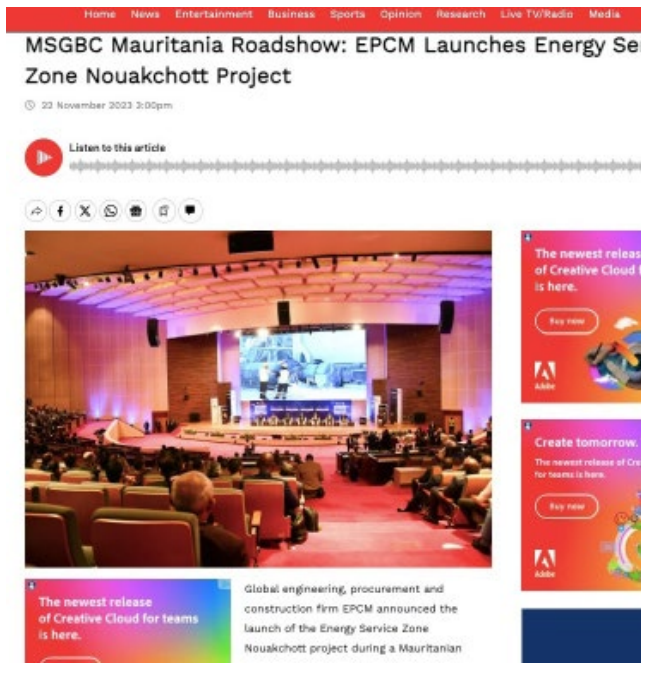
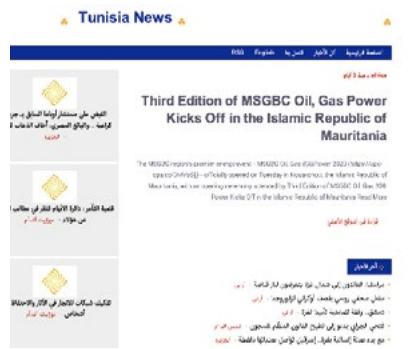
